



Care Instructions

Begonia Rex kokedama

Location:

Indoors, bright to low indirect sunlight. No direct sun on the leaves.

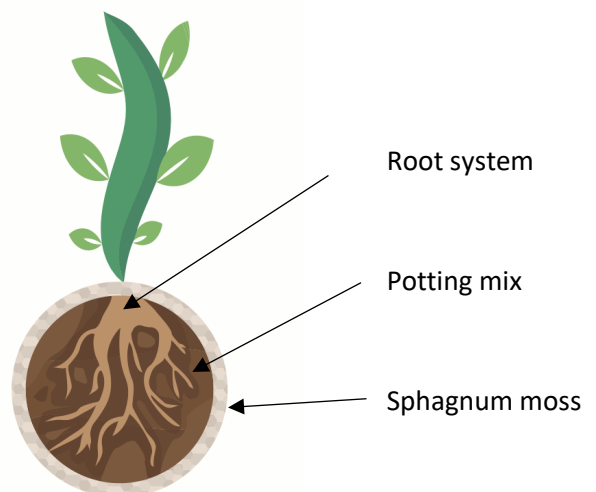
Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Keep the moss ball humid by watering from the top when it is nearly dry. It shouldn't be soggy as it would lead to root rot. In very dry weather conditions, you may put your begonia kokedama on a wet pebble tray, but not directly sitting in water. Don't spray the foliage to avoid powdery mildew.

Toxicity:

Poisonous, so keep away from children, cats and dogs.
