



Care Instructions

Blood leaf plant (*Iresine herbstii*)

Location:

Part shade to full sun. Avoid direct afternoon sun in summer. Bring indoors in winter in frost prone areas. Protect from strong winds and frost.

Prune early spring to keep the plant bushy.

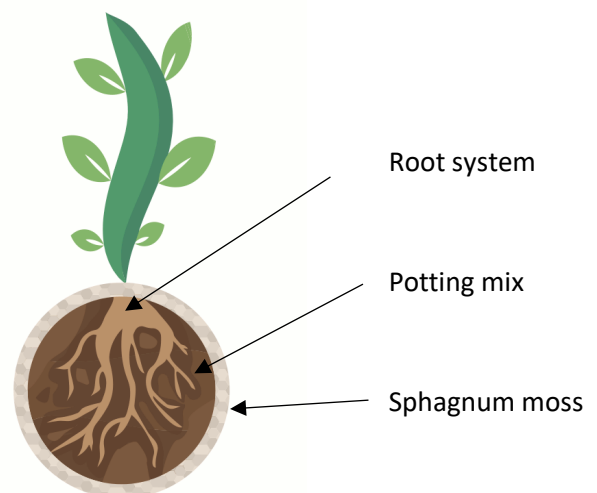
Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Keep the moss ball moist in spring and summer by watering from the top when it is about half dry. Let drain, then place back on a saucer or stand. Blood leaf plants need less water in autumn and winter, but you should never allow the soil to dry out.
