



Care Instructions

Bougainvillea

Location:

outdoor, full sun, warm position; protected from strong winds preferably. Frost tender. Deciduous if there's a dry season, evergreen if there is water all year round.

Watering:

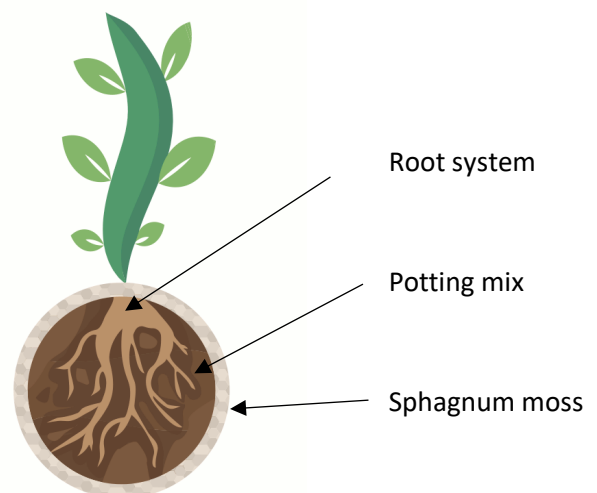
As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Water the moss ball from the top once it is nearly but not totally dry (it prefers to be slightly moist). Tolerant of short dry periods once established.

Prune after flowering to encourage new flowering wood. Avoid high nitrogen fertiliser as it encourages leaf growth at the expense of coloured bracts and the tiny white flowers inside.

Toxicity:

Non toxic but the thorns may cause a cut.
