



Care Instructions

Chilli

Location:

full sun, preferably outdoor or indoor for a few weeks to a couple of months.

Picking fruits regularly will help prolong the fruiting season.

Tolerate light frosts.

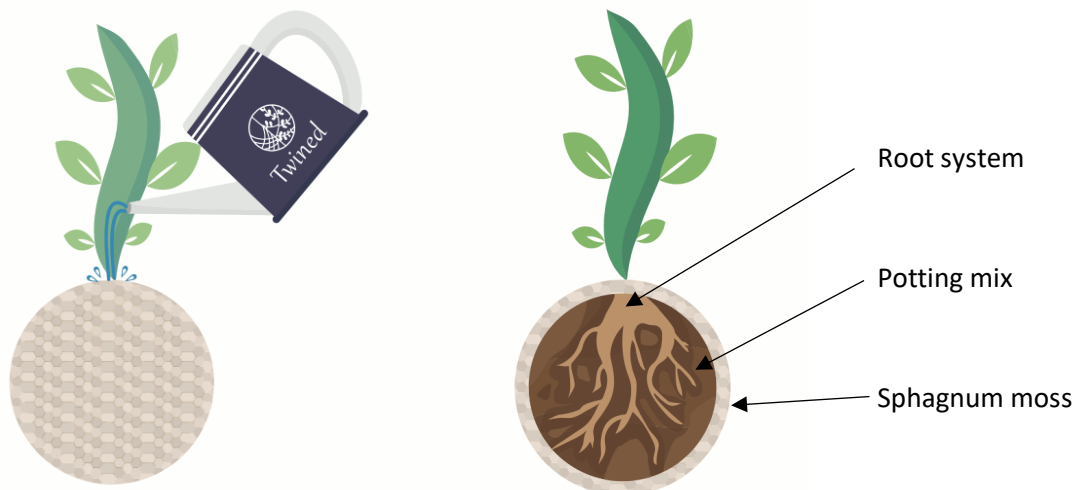
Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Don't let the moss ball totally dry out. Water the moss ball from the top near the stems before it becomes totally dry. Add slightly diluted liquid fertiliser in the watering can per product directions to feed this fruiting plant.

Toxicity:

Stems, leaves and fruits are toxic to cats and irritant to dogs.
