



Care Instructions

Chinese Lantern (Abutilon)

Location:

Prefers part shade in warmer months, or morning to midday full sun. Can tolerate full sun in cooler month.

Prune it in spring to retain its shape so it won't get leggy. Chinese lantern flower from September to December and can spot flower all year round.

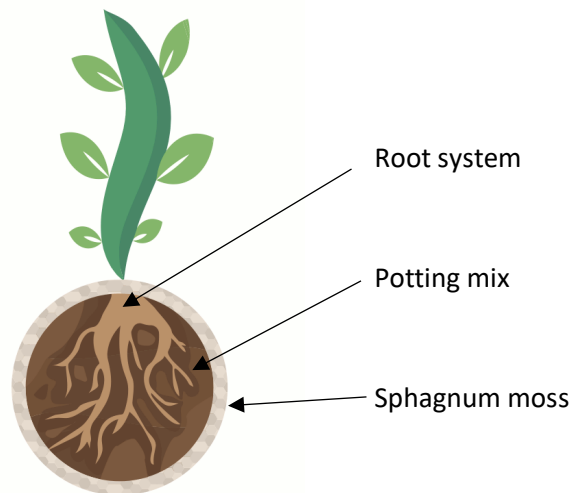
Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Water regularly from the top in the warmer months, less in the cooler months. It should be moist but not soggy.

Toxicity:

Not toxic to pets (University of California)
