



# Care Instructions

## Convolvulus Cneorum

### Location:

Full sun to part shade. Hardy evergreen.

### Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

if twined with nylon, soak the moss ball in water regularly for about 10 seconds. Let drain, soak again for 5 seconds. Let drain, place back in location.

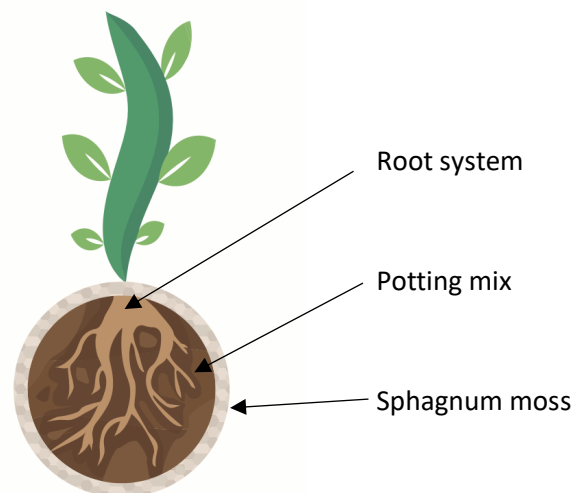
If twined with jute string, water the moss ball from the top.

Tolerates light drought and light frost once established – usually 12 weeks. Then space waterings.

You may cut it back firmly for a nice shape and encourage new growth.
