



Care Instructions

Norfolk Island Pine (Araucacia Heterophylla) | NATIVE AUSTRALIAN PLANT

Location:

Bright light with some full sun. They like moderate temperatures, moist air and bright light.

Keep away from heaters and air-cons. Bring indoors in winter as they don't like cool temperatures.

Beware: dry air, dry soil and low light can cause the needles to drop -- and they won't grow back. Norfolk Island pine is a slow-growing evergreen conifer. Don't prune or trim it.

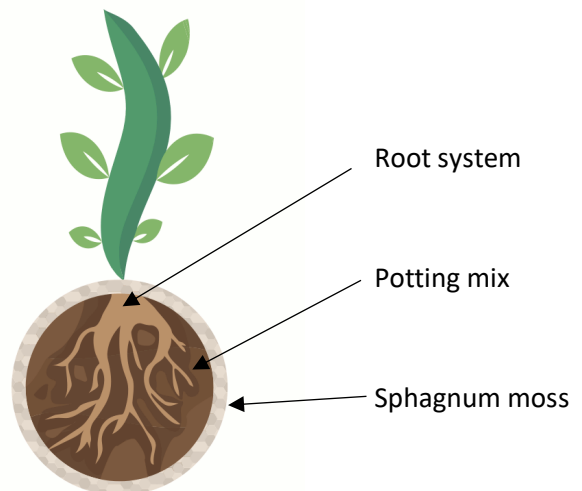
Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Always keep the moss ball slightly moist, so water from the top once the moss ball is half dry.

Toxicity:

Mildly toxic to pets
