



Care Instructions

Palm - American Cotton / Washington Palm (*washingtonia robusta*)

A very handsome and majestic palm, one of the most widely cultivated. Drought and cold tolerant (0 degree Celsius) once established.

Location:

- * Outdoors in full sun to part shade position
- * Indoors in bright light.

Watering:

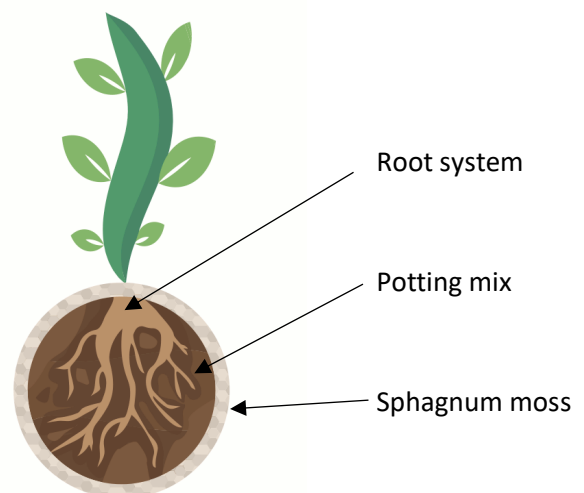
As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Keep the moss ball moist in spring and summer by watering it from the top when it's half dry. Once every 6 weeks, you may also soak the entire moss ball in a bucket of water or in your sink for about 10 seconds. Let drain then place back on a stand or saucer. Water less in cooler months.

You may add slightly diluted fertiliser in the watering can in spring and summer next year (the current potting mix already contains slow release fertiliser).
