



Care Instructions

Thyme / Lemon Thyme

Location:

Indoors or outdoors, full sun to part shade, direct or bright indirect light. Use for cooking. Trimming regularly will encourage new growth.

Watering:

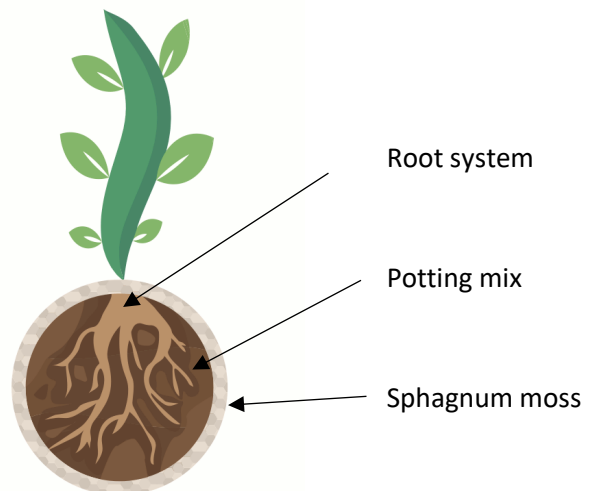
As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Water generously the moss ball from the top once it's dry. Let drain. The moss ball shouldn't be soggy though as thyme doesn't like to have wet feet. Don't let the moss ball sit in water. Let the moss ball dry out before waterings.

Add slightly diluted liquid fertiliser to the watering can and feed regularly.
