



Care Instructions

Umbrella Tree (Schefflera Amate)

Location:

Medium to bright indirect sunlight. Rotate the plant every month or so to ensure an harmonious development. If kept indoors, place at least 1 m away from a North-facing window in summer. Keep indoors in winter near a window. Keep away from heaters and aircon. Green leaves falling off is due to the light conditions being too low. You may prune it back to retain a bushy shape. Keep away from children and pets as it's mildly toxic.

Watering:

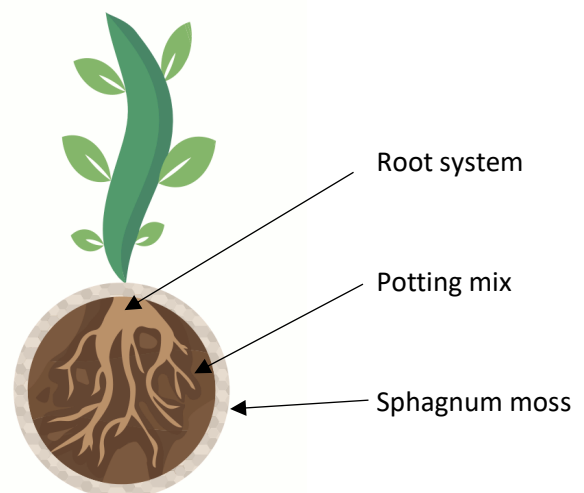
As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

Water the moss ball from the top when it feels lighter and the bottom part becomes dry. Let drain and then place back on a saucer or a stand. Mist the foliage regularly when the air is dry, and take that opportunity to dust the leaves.

Black or brown leaves are most of the time due to over-watering or cold. Yellow leaves can be due to too much or not enough water or spider mites.
