



Care Instructions

Calathea Zebrina

Location:

Indirect sunlight to shade, indoor or outdoor.

Watering:

As a rule of thumb, water your kokedama once a week or when it feels light. Adapt the watering depending on the temperature and the ambient humidity: water less frequently in cooler months, more frequently in warmer month. Windy and hot conditions tend to dry the moss ball quicker.

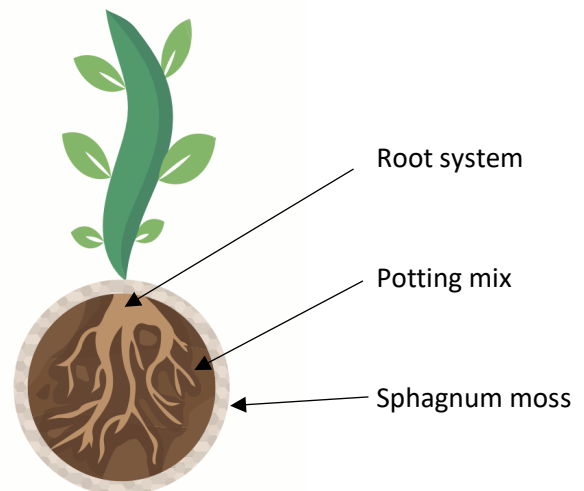
Summer: keep the moss ball moist. Water from the top when the moss ball is half dry.

Winter, when dormant, wait until the moss ball is nearly dry and use water at room temperature. Let drain before placing back on stand, plate or saucer.

The leaves roll in on themselves if it's too dry.
