



# Care Instructions

## Celosia (also called Cock's comb or Red Fox)

### Location:

Direct sun ideally for 6 to 8 hours / part shade. Thrives in hot humid Mediterranean climates. Not frost tolerant.

Celosia can flower from spring to autumn with plums of flowers. Deadhead the flower with sanitised clippers once it turns brown and loose colour, as it will encourage the plant to bloom again.

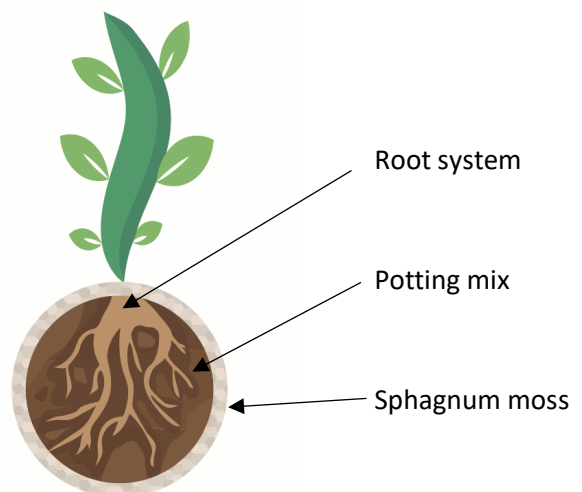
You may also cut the flower and let it dry upside down.

### Watering:

Water regularly the moss ball from the top to keep it constantly moist – but not soggy to avoid root rot.

### Toxicity:

Not toxic to cats and dogs
